



Do's and Don'ts after Driveway Sealing

- Expect to see some tire marks, possibly for several weeks, after sealcoating is done. This is especially true in the heat of the summer. This is normal and they will go away on their own.
- Do not turn your wheels while your car is sitting still. Power steering will tear the sealer film.
- If crack sealant has been applied to your driveway, it will be visible through the sealcoating.
- Do not park on freshly applied crack sealant.
- Sweep and clean any types of chemical spills on your driveway to avoid staining.
- Sweep and clean excess gravel, dirt, or stones to prevent premature wear.
- Snow plows and chains will mark or scratch the surface. Try to be conscious of this while removing snow.
